






## **New Ministry Alert: IMPACT Ministry**



### FAQ: Vaccine Access for Teachers, School Staff and Childcare Workers

The Federal Retail Pharmacy Program is prioritizing the vaccination of teachers, school staff and childcare workers during the month of March.

### Who is eligible for vaccination?

Pre-kindergarten through 12th grade teachers; licensed childcare centers and family childcare providers; Head Start and Early Head Start; and pre-k through 12th grade classroom aides, bus drivers, janitors, coun-

selors, administration staff and cafeteria

Are substitute teachers eligible for vaccination under this directive? Yes
