A Message from Pastor Bryan



After serving the school district for over 3 decades Dr. Nathan L. Fisher has been appointed as the new superintendent of the Roselle Public Schools...

Since 1990 Dr. Fisher has been employed by the Roselle Public Schools. He began his educational career as a substitute teacher to a Teacher's Aide in a Neurologically Impaired classroom. His ambitious nature allowed him to strive even harder to become a 7th grade Math Teacher; while simultaneously, serving as the Director of the Roselle Community School.



Dr. Fisher began his administrative career when he accepted the position as a Vice Principal at Abraham Clark High School, Principal of Leonard V. Moore Middle School and as the Principal of Abraham Clark High School. He is also the former principal of the National School of Character "Kindergarten Success Academy".

Overall, Dr. Fisher has served the community of Roselle for **3 Decades** and has worked his way through the educational ranks tirelessly and continuously giving to the Roselle Borough's students and families. He has been involved with numerous district wide committees from facility expansion projects, school safety initiatives, re-registration, and developing the central kindergarten school. More recently he has been promoted to the position of Superintendent of Schools, the district's highest serving leadership role.

Dr. Fisher earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Technology Education from Montclair State University, a Master of Arts degree from Kean University in Educational Leadership. Dr Fisher earned his Doctorate of Education degree in Educational Leadership from Nova Southeastern University.

Dr. Fisher has received a number of professional accolades throughout the years. He has been the recipient of numerous certificates of recognition from various local and statewide organizations for his leadership contributions. At a glance, he was awarded the Geraldine Dodge Fellowship Grant for Principal Leadership, Community Service Award from the National Council of Negro Woman, the NAACP Roselle Branch Role Model Award, and Recipient of the Roselle Chamber of Commerce Principal of the Year.

Additionally, he served as an adjunct professor at Kean and Concordia Universities' Graduate Schools of Educational Leadership. Where he taught a host of educational leadership and organizational leadership courses. Dr. Fisher is also a certified mentor for New Jersey Leaders to Leaders program for new principals and directors.

Dr. Fisher is an active member of Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church of Roselle. Currently, he sings in Men's Day and Unity Choir and he also serves as the chairperson of the Men's Ministry.

Deacon West Coleman, Jr.


Trust in the Lord, and do good Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.

- Age 16-64 with Certain Medical Conditions
- Age 65+
- Child Care Workers in Licensed & Registered Settings
- First Responders
- Health Care Workers
- ✓ Individuals Experiencing Homelessness & Those Living in Shelters
- Members of Tribal Communities
- Migrant Farm Workers
- Pre-K to 12 Educators & Support Staff
- Public Safety Workers
- Residents & Staff of High-Risk Congregate Care Facilities
- Residents & Staff of Long-Term Care Facilities
- Transportation Workers

FAQ: Vaccine Access for Teachers, School Staff and Childcare Workers

The Federal Retail Pharmacy Program is prioritizing the vaccination of teachers, school staff and childcare workers during the month of March.
